

### ANOTHER WARNING ANOTHER WARNING CORONAVIRUS SCAMS

#### Track and trace scam

A new telephone scam is coming to light .... callers contact residents saying they are from NHS Track & Trace, telling the resident that they have been in contact with someone suffering from Covid 19 and need to have a test sent out to them. This is swiftly followed with a request for the resident's bank details; the caller states that the test and results cost £500.

Please do not fall for this scam. If you need a test sent out to you because you are unable to attend a test site, this is done for free, both delivery and collection, followed up by the result.

**Important!** The NHS Test and Trace service will NOT:

- \*ask for bank details or payments
- \*ask for details of any other accounts, such as social media
- \*ask you to set up a password or PIN number over the phone
- \*ask you to call a premium rate number, such as those starting 09 or 087



## COVID-19 and Medical Ethics: A dialogue session for Catholics in healthcare

On 25 June 2020, from 7 - 8.30pm, the Anscombe Bioethics Centre is hosting a conversation about how the coronavirus pandemic has changed the landscape of medical ethics -- whether by introducing new challenges or bringing old problems to the fore. Topics for discussion include, but are not limited to, mental health, epidemiology and public health strategies, and caring for the elderly and the most vulnerable.

We're inviting Catholics in healthcare -- doctors, nurses, chaplains, students, etc. -- to join us for this online dialogue session, which will take place via Zoom. Participants will be able share their thoughts and questions with our expert panel, and there will be ample time for discussion. We are honoured to have Dr Adrian Treloar (Consultant in Old Age Psychiatry), Dr Pia Matthews (Senior Lecturer in Bioethics, St Mary's University, Twickenham) and Dr Andrew Papanikitas (GP and Senior Clinical Researcher, University of Oxford) confirmed as our panellists for the evening, and the session will be chaired by our director, Prof. David Albert Jones.
