

CHRISTMAS TREES FOR CHURCH

We need lots of these, so would love your help! We can supply some wool if you need it.

Knitted Christmas Trees.

Abbreviations: K knit; tbl through back of loop, tog together

Materials

Pair of 4.5mm (UK7) needles

100g ball each of Green and Brown or Red DK wool

6 buttons per tree(ask us if you need any materials)

Tree

Using Green yarn and using 2 strands of yarn throughout

Cast on 18sts

Row 1-4 Knit

Row 5 K1, K2 togtbl knit to last 3 stitches, K2tog, knit 1

Row 6-8 Knit

Repeat rows 5-8 3 times (10 sts)

Row 21 K1, K2 togtbl, knit to last 3 stitches, K2 tog, K1(8 stitches)

Row 22-26 Knit

Repeat rows 21 to 26 twice(4 stitches)

Row 39 K1, K2 togtbl, K1

Row 40 knit

Row 41 K1 K2 tog. Without any further knitting, cast off remaining stitches on needle.

Trunk

Using Brown or Red yarn and using 2 strands of yarn throughout

With right sides facing , pick up and knit 8 stitches from centre of cast on edge.

Knit 5 rows. Cast off knitwise.

Sew in all the ends. See 6 buttons evenly spaced on tree.

WE WILL ATTACH A RIBBON OF REQUIRED LENGTH TO THE TOP OF THE TREES,SO IT FITS AROUND THE PEWS AT CHRISTMAS TIME. THANK YOU.
